
Installing your Framed One Page Bible

This frame anchors into drywall and uses springs to hold your One Page Bible taut, a bit like a trampoline. Here's a quick overview of how you'll install it.


What you'll need:


- A level
- A pencil
- A stud finder (optional)
- A drill with a half-inch bit and a Phillips head bit
- Gloves and safety glasses

Everything else you need will be in the box.




Open the bottom frame piece and position it on the wall.






If the holes fall on studs, you'll screw the frame to the wall. If they don't, you'll use drywall anchors. Both screws and anchors are included.


Slide the side pieces into place.





Slide the top piece into place and screw or anchor it as you did on the bottom.

Attach the springs that run around the inside of the frame to the grommets that run around the outside of the print. We've included a small hook tool that makes this easy.



Close the frame over the springs, leaving a taut print with a museum-quality look.
